



2018 - 2019 U13/U15 PCFLL Field Lacrosse Regional Teams and Travel Program (Women and Youth)

INFORMATION

The objective of the U13 and U15 BC Field Lacrosse Regional Teams and Travel Program is to assemble and develop Men's Field U13 and U15 teams and Women's Field U13 and U15 teams within the Pacific Coast Field Lacrosse League (PCFLL). In addition to travel opportunities that athletes are offered by their own local field lacrosse association programs, the purpose of this program is to expose U13 and U15 players who wish to travel to tournaments who may not have this opportunity.

As this is our third year, we want to select tournaments for the correct skill level for the Regional teams, the PCFLL, along with the Management Committee for this program, have selected the tournament destinations for this season.

EXPENSES

The cost for training sessions to be held in the Fall/Winter of 2018 with tournament registration, coaches' expenses, manager's stipend, and a uniform package (pinnie, shorts, and socks) to attend tournaments within the USA will be included in the costs involved. All athletes chosen for this program will be responsible for all their expenses including travel, accommodation, equipment, etc.

Cost (per player): \$650.00

- \$50.00 registration fee (**non-refundable**)
 - payable upon submission of Player Application
- \$600.00 payable upon acceptance to the team (**non-refundable**)

 - February 22nd – 24th

ELIGIBILITY/REGISTRATION

To be eligible for the U13/U15 BC Field Lacrosse Regional Teams and Travel Program, players must be registered to play Field Lacrosse through their local community association in the September 2018 - February 2019 Field Lacrosse season and must participate in the mandated amount of league games.

Players registered and playing community lacrosse can apply for the U13/U15 BC Field Lacrosse Regional Teams and Travel Program. Players can apply for both Team BC and the Regional Team within their boundaries. However, players who are named to the Team BC roster, will be ineligible for participation in the U13/U15 BC Field Lacrosse Regional Teams and Travel Program. Due to Team BC try-outs being held on Thanksgiving week-end, we have extended the Youth application deadline until October 15th.

The PCFLL Regional teams will set up and hold their own try-outs (if necessary) and training camps with minimum conflict with league commitments. There will be no more than two (2) practices per month.
