Adanacs:

Burnaby:

Langley:

- successful 7 vs 7
 - 28 teams this year, compared to 22 last year
 - 9 U12, 15 U15, and 4 U19
 - Nanaimo had a team in each division
 - Jason Carr suggests tiering for next year, if there are enough teams

New West:

- teams are balanced
- would like to consider a U10 division
 - 7 vs 7
 - all clubs are asked to go back and see how many U10 players there are
 - New West – 10 -12 players
 - Adanacs – 12 players
 - Surrey – about 10 players
 - Langley – 1 – 2 players
 - Poco – 2 players
 - Burnaby – 0 players
 - Kellie will ask Corrine and see how many players there are
 - maybe create something extra for these players
- Coach Teeter
 - National Women's coach
 - will come out and do a skills development clinic and something for coaches
 - October 29/30
 - for girls throughout the province
 - all age groups
 - will not charge for his time
 - but will charge for travelling and accommodations
 - about \$1 000.00 - \$1 500.00
 - will need to find funding
 - and field time
 - Chris will follow-up and let Carol know asap

 - U19 could have exhibition games at Winskill in Delta @ 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays
 - will need certified umpires for any type of game
 - U19 could go to the Turkey Shoot
 - Seattle area around November 12th
 - Kellie will email girls and see if there is an interest
 - may have some time available at the Richmond Romp

 - in Burnaby, but not finalized
- Adanacs would like to host next year's 7 vs 7 tournament
 - with support of this year's organizers
 - have the tournament over 2 days instead of one
